

Golf Policies

The following rules and policies govern play on the golf course for all members and guests. However, since no list of regulations can cover every possible situation, members and guests are expected to observe the traditional customs and courtesies of golf, always considering their fellow players and the care of the golf course.

- 1. All play shall be governed by the USGA rules, except when modified by local rules from the golf shop.
- 2. The Men's and Ladies Associations, along with the PGA Head Golf Professional shall govern all matches, tournaments, and events. Approval of play by outside events shall be at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
- 3. Tournaments and events will be publicized via email, on the bulletin boards, and through other means.
- 4. No game or contest of any character, to which the public may be invited, shall be held upon any part of the club grounds without the previous permission of the Board of Directors.
- 5. All players must register in the Golf Shop. At the time of registration, all players will be charged a \$4 Golf Fee for 18 holes or \$2 Golf Fee for 9 holes.
- 6. Guests may play with any member up to a total of five (5) times at the guest rate.
- 7. All Golf Shop Credit expires on December 15th each year.
- 8. Play will be commenced only with Golf Shop approval at either #1 tee or #10 tee. Play is not to be commenced from any other place on the Golf Course, except during authorized shotgun tournaments.
- 9. ALL MEMBERS must check in with the Golf Shop prior to their round, without exception.
- 10. 5-somes will be allowed to play only with Golf Shop approval. 6-somes are allowed from 11/1 3/31.
- 11. All practicing is to be confined to those areas designed for practice.
- 12. Players stopping for lunch after 9 holes will relinquish 10th tee privileges. They must accept the Golf Shop personnel's judgment and resume play on their approval.
- 13. Any individual damaging the golf course or carts in any manner shall be assessed the damage. Members are responsible for their guests.
- 14. Golf Course Dress Code:
 - a. Proper Attire for Men:
 - i. Collared shirt | Well-maintained t-shirt | Pants/Jeans | Shorts of medium length
 - b. Proper Attire for Women:
 - i. Shirts must have sleeves or a collar | Well-maintained t-shirt | Pants/Jeans | Shorts/skirts/skorts of medium length
 - c. Golf or tennis shoes recommended | Metal spikes are prohibited
 - d. NOT Appropriate Attire:
 - i. Tank tops | Muscle shirts | Spaghetti straps | Halter tops | Graphic t-shirts
 - ii. Cutoff jeans/pants | Sweatpants | Gym shorts
- 15. Cart regulations:
 - a. All carts are only allowed access to club grounds when the grounds are deemed acceptable for cart traffic
 - i. Excessive water, snow, or dryness may limit or restrict carts
 - b. Only two (2) riders per cart
 - c. No more than three (3) bags per cart
 - d. 3 players or less = 2 carts max per group (please pair up)
 - e. 4 players or more = 3 carts max per group (please pair up)
 - f. Driver of any cart (club or privately owned) must be 16 unless accompanied by an adult
 - g. All carts must be kept 30 feet from greens, tees, and bunkers
 - h. Keep all four tires on the cart path around tees and greens
 - i. Handicap flags are available to those with State of Colorado handicap placards
