

***Scholarship Criteria for
The Eaton Country Club Scholarship***

- Purpose:** The Eaton Country Club (ECC) Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to college-bound high school seniors or first year college students based on demonstrated academic achievement and commitment to pursuing higher education at a college, university, community college, junior college, or trade school.
- Criteria:** An eligible student must be a graduating high school senior or first year college student who: 1) is a member or immediately related to a member of the ECC; or is an employee of the ECC (McCarty's staff are not eligible for the scholarship, as this scholarship is funded by ECC members); 2) is a resident of Colorado; 3) will be enrolled as a full-time student in the upcoming summer or fall semester at a college, university, community college, junior college, or trade school. Past scholarship recipients are not eligible to re-apply.
- Application:** Application submission requirements include a high school or college transcript, an essay, and a completed application form.
- Selection Process:** Selection will be based on a combination of academic achievement; submission of a well-written, persuasive essay that describes why the candidate should receive the scholarship; and possibly an interview with the scholarship committee. The selection of the scholarship recipient is at the discretion of the ECC scholarship committee.
- Awards:** Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis. The scholarship will be disbursed once the candidate provides proof of enrollment. Each scholarship awarded will be a minimum of \$500 up to \$1000.
- Deadline:** The application must be submitted by **March 31, 2023**. Contact the ECC Scholarship Committee at eccscholarship@eatoncc.net with any questions.
